Free Advice on Proper Road Maintenance

The Maine Department of Environmental Protection and the Soil & Water Conservation Districts are teaming up to offer free technical assistance to a limited number of road associations around the state.

- What would our road association get? Staff from a participating Soil & Water Conservation District will evaluate your road and develop a road maintenance plan that includes suggestions for fixing problem areas and cost estimates.
- **Who can qualify?** Any existing road association on an unpaved private road in a lake watershed.

What does a road association need to do? The association commits to working with the District, hosting a road association meeting, and at a minimum, a board meeting to review the plan when complete.

- What is the cost? The assistance will be <u>free</u> to the selected road associations.
