LEA and MPA TEMPERATURE MONITORING BUOYS







As part of ongoing environmental research, the Lakes Environmental Association (LEA) and the Moose Pond Association (MPA) has installed temperature sensors on this lake marked by regulatory buoys.

Data loggers attached to the buoy line will measure in-lake temperature for the duration of the summer and into the fall. Temperature readings are taken every 15 minutes, providing a detailed record of how temperature changes throughout the season.
